Choose a business wallet if you need to perform corporate financial operations; choose a personal wallet if you plan to use it for personal financial operations.


Step 1

Sign up to Genome

What you need to do:

1. Go to my.genome.eu, enter your email address or your phone number.
2. Create a password (min. 8 characters, an uppercase letter, a lowercase letter, a digit), read, and confirm you agree to the Terms of use and Privacy notice by checking the box.
3. Enter the confirmation code you will receive via email or SMS.

 Please note that you'll need a valid email address or a phone number.





Step 1

Choose the wallet type

What you need to do:

1. Press the Start button to choose a wallet type (check out the descriptions next to the wallet types on the sign-up screen).
2. Select the primary wallet you'll be using: Personal or Business. You'll be able to open another business or a personal wallet later, simply note that to get verified for the business wallet, you need to be the company Director/ CEO or have the Power of Attorney to represent a business. Choose a business option if you plan to open a merchant account with Genome.



- 01** Click the “Start Verification” button.
- 02** Follow the tooltips to fill in the required information and upload your ID or passport.
- 03** Submit the form. That’s it! After the review process, your personal wallet will be available and ready to use.



What you need to do:

1. If not logged, go to my.genome.eu and sign in to your account.
2. You will start on your Dashboard page. Press the Start button to start the verification process.

 Please note that you'll need a government-issued identity card, passport or another relevant document to verify your identity.





Step 2

Fill out the form

What you need to do:

1. Enter your full name, date of birth, and ID details exactly as they appear on your official identification document.
2. Provide your official registration and home address.
3. Enter your Taxpayer Identification Number.
4. Specify your primary purpose for opening an account.
5. List the countries for incoming and outgoing transfers.

Step 2

Verify your identity



What you need to do:

1. Begin the identity verification process and follow the steps to complete it with the necessary document.






Please make sure:

- Provide only the selected document type;
- Only the original document must be presented;
- Make sure your details are clear to read, with no blur or glare;
- During the video verification you must be alone;
- Carefully follow the steps on the screen while recording a selfie video.



Identity verification

Kindly note that, to successfully join Genome, you have to complete the following actions correctly:

-  During the video verification, you must be alone
-  Don't smile and remove everything obscuring your face (e.g. glasses, hats, scarves)
-  While recording a selfie video, carefully follow the steps on the screen




4. Don't close the popup window in the web interface on my.genome.eu while you are passing the verification steps on your phone




Step 2

Verify your identity

What you need to do:

1. Follow the instructions carefully when taking an identity document photo and recording a selfie video.
2. After completing the steps on your phone, you will see a Success screen on the web interface on my.genome.eu.
3. If the verification is successful, you will receive confirmation, and a personal IBAN account will be opened automatically.

i If you need to open a business wallet, continue following the next step in this guide.



Step 2

Result: a personal wallet

Possibilities unlocked:

- A EUR IBAN account ready to use and account top-up features;
- Send low-cost money transfers to bank accounts in Europe (SEPA Credit and Instant Transfers) and free internal instant transfers within Genome;
- Open multi-currency accounts;
- Exchange currencies instantly;
- Order virtual and physical Visa debit cards;
- You can now apply to open a business wallet.

Note:

Some users may be required to verify the source of funds to complete the personal verification, see Step 5 for more details.



Step 3

Start a business wallet


- 01** Click the Start verification button on the Dashboard screen when logged in to my.genome.eu
- 02** Follow the tooltips to fill in the required information. For business verification, you will need a company registration certificate or its electronic equivalent, owner/director or a valid representative scanned document.
- 03** If the verification is successful, you will receive a confirmation, and your business wallet will be opened automatically.


Step 3

Choose your business wallet in the sidebar

You will need:

1. Enter general information about your business.
2. Provide a company registration certificate or its electronic equivalent.
3. Document listing you as an owner/director or a valid representative.

 Please note that after the registration (Step 1), you must pass the verification steps for a personal wallet (Step 2), as shown previously, if you want to open a business wallet.



Step 3

Start the business verification

What you need to do:

1. If not logged in, go to my.genome.eu and sign in.
2. You will start on your Dashboard page. Press the Start button to begin the verification process.

i If you've opened a personal wallet (Step 2) previously, you will simply continue the business wallet registration process. No need to re-enter the personal info.


Step 3

Upload your documents

What you need to do:

1. Select one of the options to verify your company. You can either upload a full company profile/extract from the business registry or upload separate company documents/certificates with the company data.
2. You can also choose to submit a link to your company's profile on the official business registry's website.

 Please note that if the business registry in your country is not public, all documents (their content) should be verified by a notary and apostilled/legalized.

Step 3

Result: a business wallet

Possibilities unlocked:

- Send business-related money transfers to other bank accounts worldwide (SWIFT, SEPA) and instant internal Genome transfers, make mass payouts;
- Open multi-currency accounts in EUR, GBP, USD, and other currencies;
- Share access to your wallet with employees to run it together;
- Get a security token for an additional level of protection for outgoing payments;
- Order corporate virtual and physical Visa cards;
- You can now apply for a merchant account(s).



Step 4

Open a merchant account


- 01** Click the Start button on the Merchants tab when logged in to your business wallet.
- 02** Follow the tooltips to fill in the required information. For merchant account, you will need a Proof of Domain Ownership, Processing and Chargeback Statement from the previous processor for 6 months.
- 03** If the verification is successful, you will receive a confirmation, and your merchant account will be ready for processing.

Step 4

Start the merchant registration

What you need to do:

1. If not logged, go to my.genome.eu and sign in to your account.
2. You will start at your Dashboard page. Check the left panel and click on the Merchant tab.
3. Press the Start button to begin the opening process.



1. Fill out your account details, including the merchant website and monthly planned turnover and agree to Terms and Conditions by checking the box and clicking the Next step button.
2. You can set and add your processing currencies with preferable settlement accounts in Genome.


Step 4

Upload documents

1. Merchant domain ownership proof
2. Processing history for the last 3 months or a business plan
3. Fulfillment/supply agreement (optional)

Step 4

- Accept cards and 40+ alternative payments on your website;
- Get payments from customers in over 20 currencies;
- Make mass payouts;
- Access multiple CMS plugins for e-commerce platforms;
- Receive in-depth reports and analytical metrics;
- Mobile SDK.



Step 5

Increase wallet limits


- 01** Click the “Increase limits” button on the Limits page in the Settings tab when logged in to your wallet.
- 02** Follow the tooltips to fill in the required information about Source of funds, Employment Status and expected income for the personal account. And Planned turnover and Previous turnover for the business account.
- 03** If the request is successful, you will receive a confirmation, and your wallet limits will be increased automatically.


Step 5

Start the wallet limits increase request

What you need to do:

1. If not logged, go to my.genome.eu and sign in to your account.
2. You will start at your Dashboard page. Check the left panel and click on the Settings tab.
3. Click the the Limits tab and press the “Increase limits” button to begin the process.

 Note that you can increase your personal or business wallet limits by selecting the desired wallet.




Step 5

2. Fill out your Source of funds, Employment Status including the Employment Position and Field of activity.
3. Provide details regarding your Expected income, Transaction activity, and attach Turnover confirmation documents.
4. Mark countries for incoming and outgoing transfers on your personal account.

3. Provide information about Previous turnover and optionally upload Annual turnover statement.
4. Indicate countries for incoming and outgoing transfers on your business account.
